

Take Heed How You Hear

Revelation 19:7,8 - Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has **made herself ready.**” **8**And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the **fine linen is the righteous acts (a right response to the revealed will of God)** of the saints.

John 15:2,3 - Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. **3**You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Luke 8:18 - Take heed therefore how ye hear: for whosoever hath (**possesses**), to him shall be given; and whosoever hath not (**possesses not**), from him shall be taken even that which he seems to (**possess**).

Acts 17:11 - These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and **searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.**

Supporting Scriptures: James 1:21-25, Isaiah 6:9-13, Hosea 4:6, John 8:31-32, Proverbs 2:1-5, Luke 12:47-49

- The will of God is to redeem a people and to transform them from darkness to light; into His very image!!
